# SATURDAY 20th MAY 2017 – ARENA EVENT

## *Class One to start at 10am sharp.*

**Class 1 – 55cm – to start at 10am**

**Class 2 – 65cm**

**Class 3 – 75cm**

**Class 4 – 85cm**

The first 8 fences will be coloured Show Jumps and the next 7 jumps will be rustic cross country style jumps. The Show Jumping phase will be timed and in the event of a tie, then the fastest time over the Show Jumping element will win. There will be an optimum time for the Cross Country section.

### THE RULES

The winner will be the rider with the fewest penalties

Dress code – Body protectors & skull caps to the current standard are compulsory.

Horses & Ponies will jump together but may be split if there are sufficient entries.

Pre-entries close on Saturday 13th May **STRICTLY NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**

- Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences) 4 penalties
- 1st Refusal 4 penalties
- 2nd Refusal 8 penalties
- 3rd Refusal Elimination
- 1st Rider Fall 8 penalties
- 2nd Rider Fall Elimination
- Horse Fall Compulsory Retirement
- Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course Elimination
- Every commenced second over or under the optimum time 1 penalty
- Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed) Elimination
