## TRACTOR PULLING ENTRY FORM 2025

All exhibitors must comply with the safety code in operation for this show. In dispute the decision of the safety officer shall be final. All exhibits must be covered by Public Liability Insurance having a minimum indemnity of £2,000,000. Insurance certificates must be produced on demand by the safety officer or any steward on site. I declare that during the period of the rally, public liability insurance of not less than £2,000,000 will cover my exhibit. In default of this declaration I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organisers of the event its officers, helpers or any person acting on their instructions or behalf, from any claim for accidental damage or personal injury whatsoever, or death howsoever caused by my exhibit and my participation in this event.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1** All tractors must be fitted with a fire extinguisher.
- 2** Any changes to the manufacturers' specifications must be advised to the insurance company. If this is not the case, the insurance may be null and void.
- 3** If you have club insurance that is all you need. Otherwise, you must have the correct insurance to tractor pull and have informed your insurance company.
- 4** The liability for incidents that occur caused by drivers other than those named on the entry form will be the direct responsibility of the entrant.
- 5** Follow the instructions of the marshals at all times.
- 6** Tractor ignition – tractors must start and stop with the driver seated on the tractor.
- 7** Roll bars or a cage must be fitted to all tractors.
- 8** Throttles must return to idle when released.
- 9** A kill flap must be fitted to the tractor's air intake which will cause the tractor to stall or be reduced to idle revs when operated.
- 10** The kill flap cable must be terminated at the rear of the tractor within easy reach of the hook person when being attached to the sledge.
- 11** All exhausts must be straight pipe if a turbo is fitted and cross bolts must be fitted in the exhaust pipe which are sufficient to stop a complete turbo impeller leaving the exhaust pipe. A minimum of two 8.8 grade bolts are required. More bolts may be required in larger diameter exhaust pipes.
- 12** All tractors must have a chassis rail running from front to back of the tractor to save the tractor splitting in half if the bell housing splits (from the start of the 2025 season).
- 13** Lap or harness belts to be fitted to seats.
- 14** Front wheels must stay in contact with the ground unless a properly adjusted wheelie bar is fitted.
- 15** Only tractor operators and crew are allowed in the pulling area and no alcohol is to be consumed within the tractor pulling area.
- 16** All tractor brakes must be in good working order.
- 17** All tractors must be fitted with wheelie bars unless using standard draw bar.
- 18** All batteries must be secured at all times.
- 19** The organisers reserve the right in any situation to refuse the persons entered to pull or access to the site, common sense keeps everyone safe and happy.

## EVENT RULES

- 1** Pulling starts at 12 noon each day and tractors should be in the area by 10am to be inspected.
- 2** A safety meeting will be held 15 minutes before the start of each pull, which all drivers must attend.
- 3** No tractor can pull until the green light is visible on the sledge AND a green flag is shown. If anything changes to red, you must stop immediately.
- 4** No alcohol is to be consumed in the tractor pulling area.
- 5** The tractor driver must not start to pull until given the all clear.
- 6** Tractors must not snatch the sledge.
- 7** Tractors must stop on the sound of the air horn.
- 8** Strictly only puller and mate are allowed in the pulling area during pulling.
- 9** No children or dogs are allowed in the pulling area.
- 10** General public are allowed in to view when there is no pulling taking place.
